Exercise Planning and Execution: ANSER provides worldwide Joint/Combined/Multi-national Training and Joint Exercise Event Life Cycle (JELC) planning. ANSER Exercise Planners apply extensive experience in Joint, Army, Air Force, Marine Corps and Special Operations communities to provide PACAF, MARFORPAC, DTRA, NGB and the Joint force with exercises that validate current plans while cultivating enhancements in Joint, Combined and Multi-Domain operations. This includes our uncommon expertise in evaluating the procedures and processes required to respond to accidents/incidents involving improvised WMD, chemical & biological agents, radiological materials through DTRA's Security Cooperation AM&E program support.

Mission Assurance/Risk Assessments: ANSER staff developed and conducted the Joint Mission Assurance Assessment Pilot and have provided installation level assessments and risk mitigation recommendations to HQ Pacific Air Forces since 2002. Our assessments are scaled and tailored to each specific installation, addressing the risks and mission sets delivered from each location. In addition, ANSER develops Defense-wide mission assurance policy and instructions through our long-time support to the ASD(HD&HA) and enhances Joint mission assurance in energy resilience through our execution of the Black Start program.

Disaster Response and Defense Support of Civil Authorities: ANSER provides instructors and facilitators to support USNORTHCOM training of senior National Guard and Title 10 leaders in effective emergency/disaster planning and response processes. ANSER helps coordinate and facilitate three classes: the JTF Commander's Course; The Joint Domestic Operations Course; and the Dual Status Commander Orientation Course (DSCOC), which prepares senior National Guard and Title 10 Deputies to integrate a cohesive and complete DoD response to disasters, CONUS and in the Pacific.
